

South Cook Math Bowl Thursday, April 28th & Friday, April 29th, 2016 Prairie State College - Chicago Heights, IL

The 2016 South Cook Math Bowl is being held at Prairie State College. This competition is open to students in grades 1 - 8. The Math Bowl will be held on 2 consecutive days with Divisions A and B competing on Thursday, April 28th and Divisions C and D competing on Friday, April 29th. Prairie-Hills Elementary School District 144 will be coordinating the Math Bowl and it is generously being funded by Crystal Financial.

Organizational Meeting:

We will have an informational meeting that will be held at the Prairie-Hills Junior High, on Friday, October 30, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this meeting will be to review the rules and structure for the day of the competition and to discuss any possible changes to the program. We will have another informational (mandatory) meeting that will be held at the Prairie-Hills Junior High, on Monday, April 04, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this meeting will be to review the rules and structure for the day of the competition, as well as distribute t-shirts, nametags, lunch tickets, etc. *Each district is required to send a representative.*

Competition Schedule:

Check-in: 8:15 – 8:45 AM Competition: 9:00-11:30 AM Lunch/Entertainment: 11:45-1:00 PM Awards: 1:15 PM

Description of the Competition:

The competition consists of four events – two are individual events and two are team events. The team events for all divisions will include various Math Olympiad/algebraic problems and number puzzles for Part A and KenKen and logic puzzles for Part B. Each group must discuss and answer the problems as a team and each team will submit one answer sheet.

Team Composition:

Districts are *limited* to one team per division and *each team has four members*. All divisions must include two representatives from each grade level. The team divisions are:

Division A	Grades 1-2
Division B	Grades 3-4
Division C	Grades 5-6
Division D	Grades 7-8

Scoring: Grade Level Awards

One point is given for each correct answer. Points earned by each participant on the individual events are tabulated to determine the top individual scorers at each grade level.

Scoring: Team Awards

Team rankings will be tabulated by totaling the scores for the two team events, only. Individual scores will not be included in tabulating the team scores. If there is a tie, the individual scores of the division will be added to the team scores to break the tie. The team with the highest score will win placement on the team event winners list.

Awards:

There will be medals awarded to the top <u>six (6) scoring students in each grade level</u>. There will be plaques awarded to the top six (6) teams in each of the four (4) divisions.

Rules:

- All supplies necessary for the competition will be provided for students.
- Calculators, compasses, rulers, etc. are not allowed.
- No help may be given to students once they are seated in their assigned rooms.
- No contact should be made with the students from district personnel unless requested by Math Bowl personnel.
- No snacks are to be delivered to students. The only exception being students who must have specific snacks due to medical needs.

Competition Questions:

Questions for mental math, grade level events and team events will be aligned to the Common Core Standards (CCSS). All areas of mathematics will be covered including: computation, number sense, patterns, sequencing, estimation, measurement, data analysis, prediction, algebra and geometry.

Proctors and Runners: Each district must supply **two (2)** adults to serve as proctors, runners and scorers. The names of the adult volunteers must be submitted at the time of registration for the 2016 South Cook Math Bowl.

Lunch:

Lunch will be served for all student team members and the adult volunteers from each district. Additional lunches can be ordered. Please request the number of additional lunches needed when you register. Additional lunches may be ordered at the cost provided by Prairie State College.

Awards Ceremony:

The Awards Ceremony will take place in the Auditorium at 1:15 p.m. Depending on the amount of districts participating in this event, each student participant will be given two (2) tickets for the Awards Ceremony and each district will receive 4 additional tickets for special guests. This will entitle each student to have two family guest members and 4 district guest members to attend the Awards Ceremony. The tickets will be given to the contact person at the mandatory meeting in April. <u>Guests are welcome to join us for the entertainment, beginning at 12:20</u> **p.m.** (which will also take place in the auditorium prior to the awards presentation).

Participation Application/Registration Deadline:

Each district will need to complete an Initial Application, which includes the name and <u>email address</u> of the designated District Contact and the number of teams that will be competing. This form must be submitted no later than Friday, February 19th. <u>The fee is \$40 per division team and should be included with the Initial Application.</u> Checks should be made out to Prairie-Hills Elementary School District 144.

A team entry application is also required which includes the names and grades of the students that are participating. The team entry application must be received by Wednesday, March 11th.

South Cook Math Night:

The Chicago White Sox are once again sponsoring a 2016 South Cook Math night. All students and staff who participated at any level of their district's preparation and implementation of the Math Bowl are invited to attend. The game that we will be attending will be announced at a later date. Tickets are significantly reduced and are available for advance purchase. A flyer will be available for all districts at the April 04th mandatory meeting.

Most Valuable Player (MVP):

We are asking each district to select a District MVP; one for each of the two days of the Math Bowl. If your district is not participating at all levels, please choose one student for the day(s) you are competing. It is our goal that every district send someone to the stage for recognition on the day(s) that they are participating. These students should be chosen based on the criteria below. Please bring the names of your MVP, Junior Level (Thursday) and Senior Level (Friday) winners to the April 04th meeting.
