

eLearning Program Verification Form

According to Section 10-20.56 of the School Code [105 ILCS 5/10-20.56], school districts may, by adopted resolution, utilize "eLearning days" in lieu of emergency days. The number of eLearning days may not exceed the number of emergency days in the approved school calendar. The district's eLearning program must be verified by the regional office of education or intermediate service center for the school district prior implementation. Before adoption, the school board must hold a public hearing for initial proposal or renewal of eLearning Program by:
