



## Chrome Canvas

2. Click on New Drawing button




## Saving Whiteboards as an Image



1. Click on the three dots in the upper right-hand corner.
2. Select SAVE IMAGE.
3. Post image in Google Classroom.


# Jamboard

1. Log in to your district Google account.




2. Click on the waffle & select the Jamboard app.

3. Click on the + sign in the bottom right corner to create a new jam.



# Sharing Jamboards in Google Meets



1. Click on the blue SHARE button to open sharing settings.

2. Under WHO HAS ACCESS click CHANGE.



3. Select “On – Anyone at Prairie-Hills SD144 with the link”

4. Under ACCESS change “can view” to “can edit”

5. Click SAVE

6. Copy the link & click DONE.

7. Paste the link in the Meets chat window so students can collaborate on the virtual whiteboard.
