Dear Parents:

This is an exciting time for you and your child. This is his/her eighth grade year, and there are many exciting activities to culminate this school year. The students have the dinner dance, an 8th grade trip, a ribbon pinning ceremony, and most important, the graduation. As you know, maintaining excellent grades and positive behavior is a priority here at Prairie Hills Junior High School. To ensure that students stay focused, the administration have instituted the following guidelines. These guidelines will be strictly enforced by all staff members. Students who are consistently exhibiting negative behavior will not be allowed to attend 8th grade events. The specific guidelines are listed below:

Each 8th grade student will be given **175 points** at the start of the point system window and also an additional **175 points** in January. A total of **350 points** will be given to each student for the year! They will have points awarded or deducted from this total based on their behavior and grades. The goal is to reward those students who do what they are supposed to and motivate those students who may struggle in specific areas.
