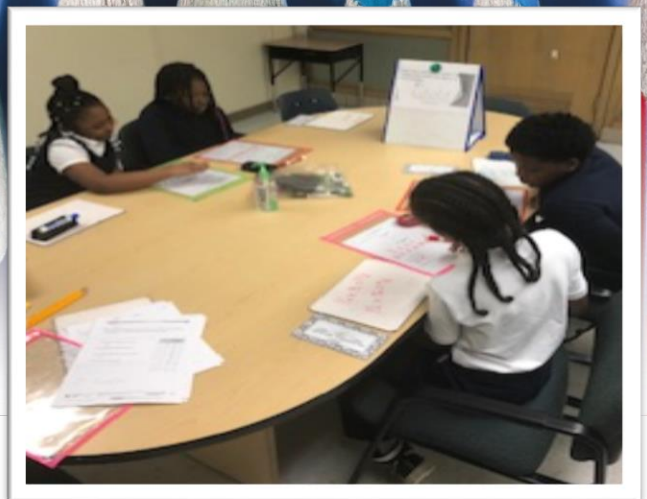
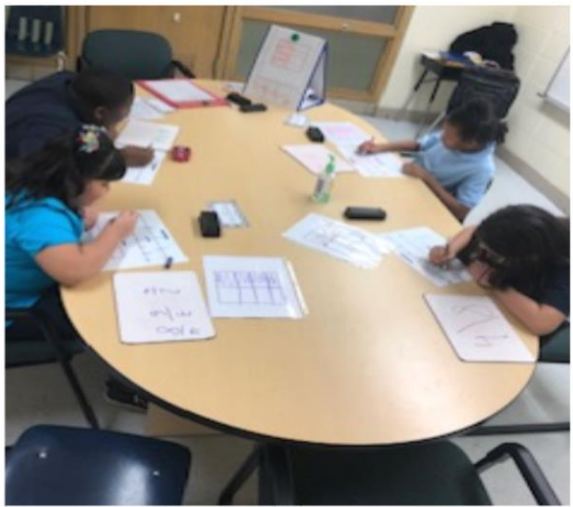

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3RD GRADE UPDATE!

STANDARDS:

- 3.NF.3 (Equivalent fractions & comparison)

SKILL/ACTIVITY:

- Determine equivalent fractions on a number line as well as using other visual representations
- Using multiplication of fractions that equal a whole to determine equivalent fractions

4TH GRADE UPDATE!

STANDARDS:

- 4.MD.1 (Measurement unit conversion) customary
- 4.NF.1 (Equivalent fractions)
- 4.NF.3abcd (Fractions are composed of unit fractions)

SKILL/ACTIVITY:

- Adding like fractions to make a whole
- Converting units of measurement i.e. units within capacity
- Determine equivalent fractions

5TH GRADE UPDATE!

STANDARDS:

- 5.NF.4 (Multiply fraction or whole number by fraction)
- 5.NF.6 (Solve problems involving multiplication of fractions and mixed numbers)

SKILL/ACTIVITY:

- Demonstrate understanding of multiplication of fractions and mixed numbers by playing games and solving word problems
- Showing visual representations of multiplying fractions
